

RECYCLING JACKSON UPDATE

Thank you for being patient with us during the COVID pandemic. We will be reopening for services on June 6, 2020. We will have some different operating procedures for your and our staff's protection. Please review the changes so you are not surprised when you arrive.

Temporary changes to our operation to comply with COVID -19 safety guidelines:

- All visitors must stay in their vehicle.
- All visitors must wear masks while on site
- All staff must wear masks on site
- All recyclables must be in the car trunk or the bed of the truck
- Recycling Jackson staff will unload that material from the trunk or bed of a truck
- Recycling Jackson staff will not unload material from back seats.
- If material is in the back seat of a vehicle the driver/occupants will need to unload it and set it on the ground or put it in the appropriate bin.
- We will only allow two vehicles on the site at any one time - this will result in longer than desired lines so be prepared to wait.
- For large TVs unloading assistance will be required by the visitor.

NEW PRICES EFFECTIVE JUNE 1, 2020

PAINT - \$2 gallon; 4 quarts equal one gallon; 8 pints will be considered one gallon.

PLEASE have the gallon equivalents counted when you arrive.

Television handling charges:

CRT Televisions and monitors:

Small \$5: 13-inch screen size or less

Medium \$10: 14 inches to 27 Inches

Large: \$20 Over 28 Inches

FLAT Screen TVs and monitors:

No charge up to 50 Inch screen size. \$5 for TVs with 50 Inch screen or larger.

PROJECTION TVs: We NO LONGER accept during our monthly drop offs. Projection TVs will be accepted at community collection events. Watch our Facebook page and website for dates.
